The above schedule shall not be used, nor be applicable to the following cases:

- 1.) A defendant who has been arrested for a crime while on formal/supervised probation, parole, or is out on bond for another offense.
- 2.) Any person arrested on a charge of Domestic Battery (Felony and Misdemeanor), invasion of Privacy or Stalking, whereby the defendant is capable of appearing before a Magistrate or Judge for initial hearing within 48 hours. In the event that a defendant is arrested within 48 hours of the Courts being open, the defendant shall be held without bond pending an initial appearance before the Court for the purpose of setting bond, bond conditions, court dates, and if appropriate, No Contact Orders.
- 3.) In the event that a defendant is arrested for the charges outlined in Paragraph 2, and prior to 48 hours before the Courts are open, bond shall be set at \$5000.00 cash.
